Tools for Prayer and Bible Reading P.R.I.S.M.

Praise = Praise God for who he is and what he has done

Repentance = Acknowledge any sin that God has revealed

Intercession = Praying for other people

Supplication = Praying for your own personal needs

Meditation = What passage of scripture has spoke to your heart or means something to you.

How to Journal Using S.O.A.P. Method

Pray (5 minutes) use a list you have prepared.
Read your Bible (10 minutes) - 1 Chapter a Day!
Journal using S.O.A.P. method (5 minutes).

S = Scripture:

Write down a meaningful scripture from your reading

O = Observation:

write 2-3 Sentences observation" about this passage

A = Application:

Write a 1-2 Sentences of personal "Application" about this passage

P = Prayer

Close in prayer (5 minutes)

S.O.A.P. Example

Friday, September 19

"The Only Thing"

S Galatians 5:6b "The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love."

(The ONLY thing that counts, that has meaning, value or merit, the only thing that really matters or that I should even concern myself with is ... faith! But faith needs to be expressed — not as a duty or obligation or because it earns me favor with God — but expressed through loving God and loving people.

O

For me, faith expressing itself through love might mean serving people cheerfully when I don't really feel like it. Maybe I need to say a kind word to someone who hasn't been nice lately.

A Maybe it means praying to God — joyfully! — when I'm tired or frustrated or confused. This is the time I need to thank God ahead of time ... and love Him — that's faith!

P Thank you, Lord, for the ability to engage in the only thing that counts: Faith expressing itself in love. Amen!
